The Feminisms and Gender Studies Research Group of the *Real Escuela Superior de Arte Dramático de Madrid* (RESAD) and the *Asociación Internacional de Teatro del Siglo XXI* (AITSXXI) organize the «VII International Seminar of Theater and Feminisms of the RESAD: **Living Masters: contributions of women in theatrical pedagogy (1920-2020)**», which will take place at RESAD from February 12 to 14, 2020.

The purpose of these gatherings is to promote the meeting between national and international artists and researchers to expose the results of their inquiries, as well as to encourage the exchange of ideas, methodologies, conceptual tools and research practices, establishing international networks around the seminar topics of research and their dissemination.

#### **RATIONALE**

Within a professional area as pedagogy is which in certain contexts is considered as being feminized, the contribution made by women, either masters or teachers, to the advancement and development of pedagogy remains, paradoxically, poorly visible. In spite of all the work already done, we still lack the necessary enhancement of projects, experiences and testimonies, updating the scientific knowledge that has been developed and focusing wherein shadows remain. Because we believe that the visibility of women's work in the performing arts is needed, as well as the presentation of a broader field of models and references.

So for all of this, our referential workspaces and areas of reflections are the following:

- Working methodologies in theatre directing, creation and stage design made by women and/or with a feminist perspective.
- Projection of sexist stereotypes on stage, theatrical texts and the interpretation and performance of female roles and characters
- Systems and methods of actor training that promote positive attitudes towards the feeling body and enhance its abilities
- Deontology in professional practice and theatrical pedagogy

#### **THEMES**

- 1. Pedagogues: feminist experiences, applied theater and methodologies
- 2. Reference models: canon, genealogy and bibliographies
- 3. Masters in stage practices and professions: memory and transmission
